Policies and procedures are the foundation of any security program. That is why HIPAA § 164.316 sets forth specific requirements for all policies, procedures and documentation required by the Security Rule. Specifically, it requires that covered entities: “Implement reasonable and appropriate policies and procedures to comply with the standards, implementation specifications, or other requirements of this subpart”. Within this requirement is flexibility in what your policies say but no flexibility in the requirement that they exist and are followed.
