

Methodology

HIPAA 45 CFR Part 160 and Part 164, Subparts A and C set security standards and require each covered entity to adopt administrative, physical, and technical safeguards. STANDARD § 164.308(a)(5) requires that a covered entity must "Implement a security awareness and training program for all members of its workforce (including management)." Regardless of how complete or detailed your safeguards are they will not protect ePHI if the workforce is unaware of its role in adhering to and enforcing them.
