The Risk Assessment will be conducted based on the globally recognized NIST SP-800-30, SP-800-66 and CMS Final Guidance for Conducting a Risk Assessment. In addition, the audit protocols developed by the Office for Civil Rights (OCR) will be used to provide a framework for making high-level strategic recommendations, with the intent of enhancing Client's overall compliance with the protocols used by OCR for investigations and audits.



The Results

A narrative report is provided which is structured to meet the requirements of OCR and Meaningful Use auditors. Strategic and detailed recommendations are provided and prioritized based upon the risk scores assigned.
